From ecological science to grassroots conservation, **UHasselt** shows how universities can be catalysts for biodiversity change.

Q WASP Project – Why do we love certain animals more than others? Through this innovative citizen science project, UHasselt explores the psychology behind our attitudes toward species. Participants compare photos of animals—voting on which is cuter, more dangerous, or more endangered—to uncover how public perception aligns (or doesn't!) with real conservation priorities. The findings will help bridge the gap between science, society, and policy.

A Green Campus Transformation

On the **Diepenbeek campus of UHasselt**, what was once overlooked has become a flagship example of integrated biodiversity management. Through partnerships with **Natuurpunt**, **ANB**, and **Provinciaal Natuurcentrum**, UHasselt codeveloped a master plan that values the unique mosaic of grasslands, woodlands, and wetlands across 18 hectares of the Demervallei. A recent concession allows Natuurpunt to manage the site for 25 years—a huge milestone for long-term nature stewardship!
