Autumn — and especially **November** — is the ideal time to plant trees, hedges, and shrubs. Cooler weather and moist soil help roots settle before winter, giving plants a strong start next spring. Choose native species and create small pockets of habitat for pollinators and birds.





Project in the spotlight

Since planting their first Miyawaki forest in 2016, **Urban Forests** has created over **56,000** m² of micro-forests across more than 100 projects in Belgium and France. Using the **Miyawaki method**, they restore soil health, plant native species densely, and allow forests to regenerate naturally with minimal maintenance.

These micro-forests reduce heat islands, improve air quality, prevent erosion, and create homes for countless species — proving that even small patches of green can have a big impact.
