Tip of the month

Turn off the night lights: Outdoor lighting disrupts bats, insects and birds. Switch off unnecessary lights at night to give wildlife a darker, safer winter habitat. 



Project in the spotlight

IPON integrates biodiversity as a core element of its construction projects. For every development, a legally binding planting plan — designed by a landscape architect — ensures that green spaces are an essential part of both private and communal areas. Residents commit to maintaining native plants and ecological structures, supported by clear green guidelines and inspiration from book *De wilde tuin* (The Wild Garden). This long-term approach strengthens local ecosystems, supports wildlife and creates green, community-oriented living environments — a model IPON has successfully applied for decades.

Jane Goodall Institute (JGI)

Belgium has been a proud partner of the BBA since the very beginning. Through forest restoration in Belgium and in Burundi (Africa), including projects like [Forest in One Day](#), JGI helps to bring degraded landscapes back to life while strengthening climate resilience and biodiversity.

At the same time, their **Roots & Shoots** movement inspires young people to take action to make the world a better place for people, other animals, and the environment, and to be an example for others in their own network.



Inspired by the pioneering work of Dr. Jane Goodall, JGI shows that every person can make a difference for a more nature-positive world. Although missing tremendously their founder dr. Jane who passed away on 1st October last year, JGI Belgium and all other national JGIs decided to continue their work to keep her legacy and memory alive.
